

SAB HARMON IS NOW IN BUSINESS

Operations of the former American SAB Company, Broadview, Ill., including the manufacture of its slack adjusters, were moved to SAB Harmon Industries' plant at Warrensburg, Mo., April 1. SAB Harmon was formed late last year after the acquisition of the American SAB by Harmon, and the purchase of 51% of Harmon's stock by SAB Industries, Malmo, Sweden. Harmon manufactures railway electronic, communications, and grade-crossing equipment; SAB is an international supplier of brakes, slack adjusters, and resilient wheels. Sales and marketing operations of the units will be closely integrated to provide expanded worldwide service.
